THE PROPERTY IS GENERALLY LOCATED AT THE NORTHWEST INTERSECTION OF FM 663 AND LENA LANE, COMMONLY KNOWN AS 1111 S. 9TH STREET. (CASE NO. Z29-2023-112).

Mayor Coffman opened the Public Hearing and Brian Guenzel presented the Item. Midlothian resident, Kris Rolek addressed Council in opposition to the Item. With no further public input received, Councilmember Moorman moved to close the Public Hearing. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Gardner and carried unanimously (7-0). The Applicant, Jeff Bucknam, addressed Council in support. Councilmember Hammonds moved to approve Item 2024-008 as presented, with the following conditions: addition of a right-in, right-out ingress-egress to the 9th Street driveway access; and, the number of parking spaces to be specified in the ordinance as 14. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Hartson and carried unanimously (7-0).

Mary Elliott presented the Item. Midlothian resident, Debra Markwardt addressed Council in support of the Item. With no further public input received, Councilmember Moorman moved to close the Public Hearing. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Hammonds and carried unanimously (6-0). Councilmember Moorman moved to approve Item 2024-009 as presented, subject to a revision in the tree species from Desert Willow to Cedar Elm. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Rodgers and carried unanimously (6-0).

Mayor Coffman returned to the dais.

2024-010 CONDUCT A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER AND ACT UPON AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE USE AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS OF PLANNED DEVELOPMENT NO. 106 TO ALLOW FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW DATA CENTER BUILDING AND ACCESSORY STRUCTURES RELATING TO THE BUILDING. THE PROPERTY IS GENERALLY LOCATED AT LOT 1, BLOCK 1, SHARKA MDN ADDITION. LOCATED OFF OF U.S. HIGHWAY 67, BETWEEN RAILPORT PARKWAY AND V.V. JONES ROAD. (CASE NO. Z34-2023-127).

Motion was seconded by Mayor pro tem Wickliffe and carried unanimously (7-0). Mayor pro tem Wickliffe moved to approve Item 2024-010 as presented. Motion was seconded by Councilmember Hammonds and carried unanimously (7-0).

2024-011 CONDUCT A PUBLIC HEARING AND CONSIDER AND ACT UPON AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE USE AND DEVELOPMENT OF 71.737+ ACRES IN THE J. SHARKEY SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 1065, J.T. RAWLS SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 933, AND THE W.P. KERR SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 609 BY CHANGING THE ZONING FROM PLANNED DEVELOPMENT NO. 94 (PD-94) AND LIGHT INDUSTRIAL (LI) DISTRICT, TO PLANNED DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT NO. 171 (PD-171) FOR COMMUNITY RETAIL (CR) ADOPTING DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS INCLUDING A CONCEPTUAL SITE PLAN, SIGN ELEVATIONS, OUTDOOR DISPLAY AND STORAGE PLAN, LANDSCAPE PLAN, AND ELEVATION/FAÇADE PLAN. THE PROPERTY IS GENERALLY LOCATED ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF WEST MAIN STREET, EAST OF HIGHWAY 67 AND NORTH OF STATE SPUR 73. (CASE NO. Z24-2023-075).

Mayor Coffman opened the Public Hearing and Mary Elliott presented the Item. With no public input received, Councilmember Gardner moved to close the Public Hearing. Motion was seconded by Mayor pro tem Wickliffe and carried unanimously (7-0). Councilmember Hammonds moved to approve Item 2024-011 with the following ordinance amendments: Section 2 - F(11) – All streets and parking areas will be concrete; Removal of Section 2 - G(3) – Electronic Signs; Section 2 – F (10a) Portions of the Property developed for purposes other than a Large Format Store or Home Improvement Store shall be constructed with no more than 30% of the parking spaces nine (9) feet wide by 18 feet deep located on a two-way drive aisle that is not less than 24 feet wide, where the spaces are perpendicular (90 degrees) in relation to the drive aisle. All remaining parking spaces shall be ten (10) feet wide by 18 feet deep; and, white cornice to be added to the Home Improvement Store façade. Motion was seconded by Mayor pro tem Wickliffe and carried by a vote of 5-2, with Councilmembers Gardner and Hartson voting in opposition.

Motion carried by a vote of 4-3, with Councilmembers Moorman, Gardner and Hartson voting in opposition.
